#### ACTION TAKEN REPORT

## The analysis of the feedback collected from alumni revealed the following findings:

- There should be more opportunities for interaction between teachers and students to enhance the learning experience.
- The curriculum should include more internships that actively engage students and align with their career goals.
- There is a need to expand extra-curricular activities to help students cultivate a broader range of skills and interests.
- Incorporating more research opportunities alongside academic studies will strengthen the department's research capabilities and benefit the students.

## Action taken based on the findings:

- Regular interactive sessions, such as group discussions, Q&A sessions, and peer learning activities, have been integrated.
- In the four year UG programme scheduled to commence from the academic year 2024— 25, a two week internship is mandatory for students after the second semester of the programme.
- Various skill development programmes were conducted to enrich the skills of their interest.
- Research opportunities were enhanced by hosting workshops and seminars, integrating research projects into the curriculum, and establishing additional research centers.
