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






## Alumni Lecture Series 2023






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#### Field Visit: School of Chemical Sciences M.G University








#### **Best Student Teacher competition**


Magazine at the ceremony. The prizes were distributed by the above-mentioned dignitaries.


## **Invocation ceremony and Fresher's party**



The Post Graduate Department of Psychology organized the 'World Mental Health Day






#### **International Day of Democracy**








#### **World Population Day**






## Academic Year: 2021-2022






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#### International volunteer day for economic and social development.







### **Digital Magazine 2021**




#### Film Festival -Prism 2021
