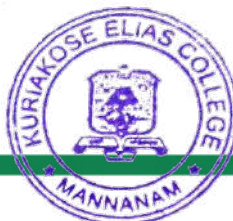


Distribution of Grocery Kits

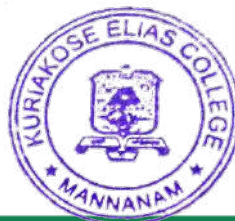
6. Cleaning program at Kallara

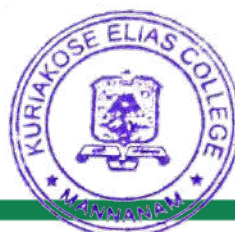

On 24th August 2018, a team of 73 students, 8 teachers including three programme officers Dr. Brigit Paul, Mr. Prajod Sunny, Mrs. Neethu Jose and Staff Secretary Vinu J George, 3 members of administrative staff and 4 alumni gathered at Kallara Panchayat Office at 10 am. The Panchayath President Mrs. Jameela Pradeep and other Panchayat members were also present. TT injection and other medical precautions were given to the students and teachers by Dr. Jayanthi of Kallara PHC and her team. Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) and cleaning essentials such as mops, brooms, cleaning lotions were also provided from the Panchayath Office. Thereafter the cleaning drive team proceeded to Akathanthra Colony. The colony was flooded for about one week and the water receded only a day before the cleaning drive. The houses were filled with mud and water. The furniture and other things in the houses were taken out for cleaning the floors and walls. The floors and walls were cleaned with lotions and bleaching powder. Taking into consideration the safety of the students, the students were not allowed to clean certain places in the colony where snakes were spotted by the locals in the morning. The team cleaned 19 houses in Akathanthra Colony.

The team returned to Kallara NSS High School which was a flood relief camp where about 350 people were rehabilitated. The team joined for the lunch with the inmates. We met some of our students there who were the inmates of the camp. Ms. Chinnu Mohan, teacher of MSW, Department with five students stayed back in the camp and conducted entertainment programme for the children in the camp. They got very good response from all members.

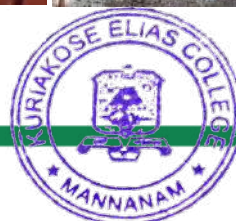

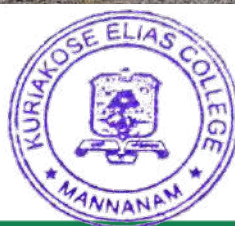

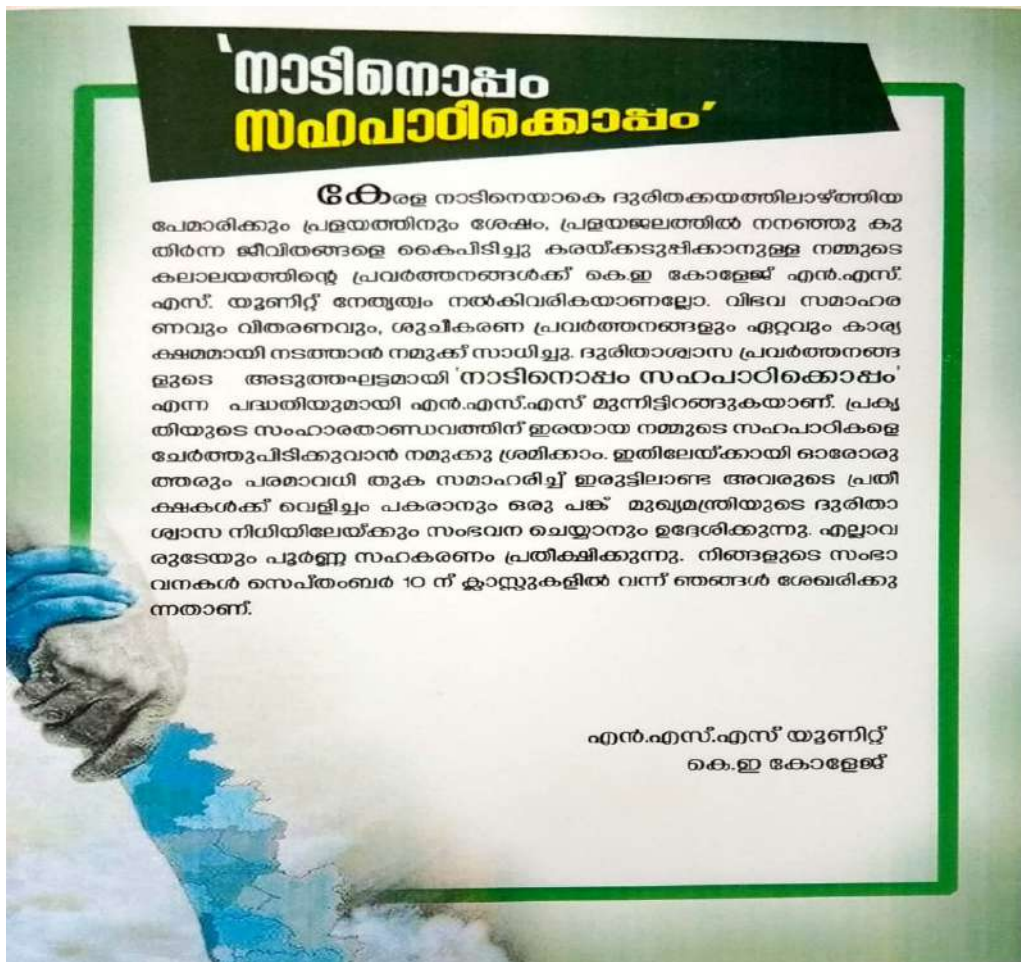


7. Financial help to flood affected students – ‘Nadinoppam Sahapadikkoppam’
