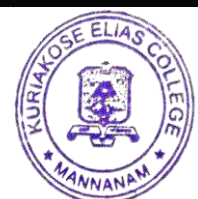






### 3. ARTS CLUB INAUGURATION

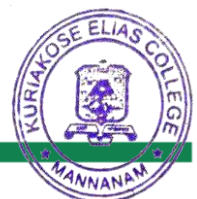






### 5. ETHNIC DAY

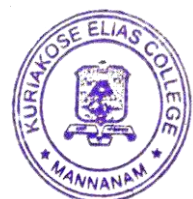

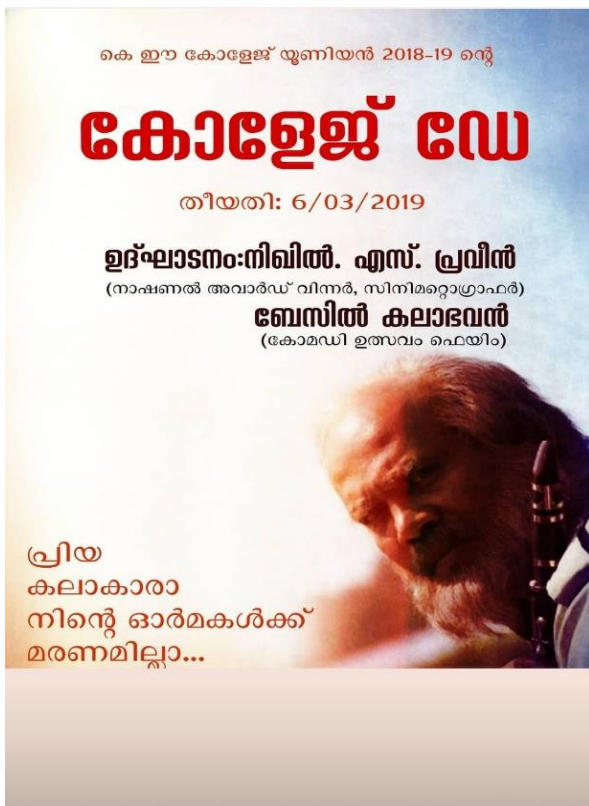






### 7. COLLEGE DAY 2019
