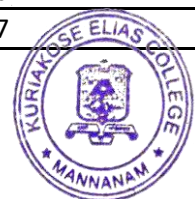
BEST STUDENT TEACHER COMPETITION, K. E. COLLEGE, MANNANAM (DEPT OF STATISTICS)

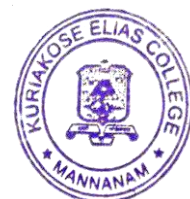
Report of Essay Competition

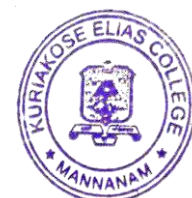




INTERCOLLEGIATE QUIZ COMPETITION KUISA LIONA (ZOOLOGY DEPARTMENT)

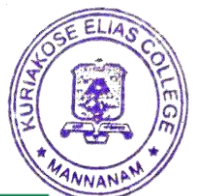

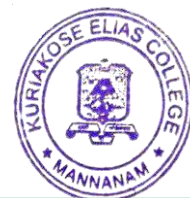

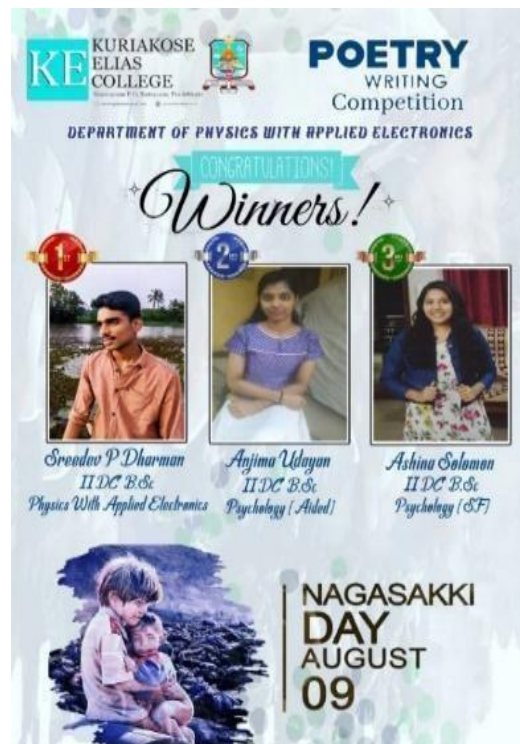

NAGASAKI DAY- POETRY WRITING COMPETITION (APPLIED ELECTRONICS DEPARTMENT)

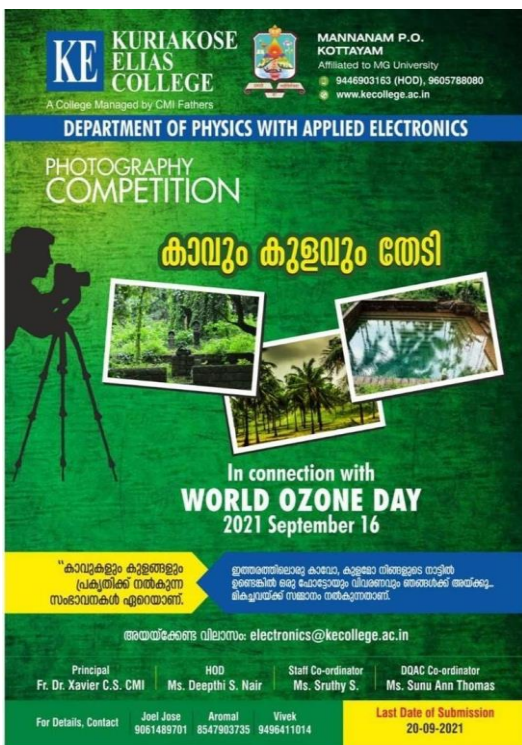

WORLD OZONE DAY - PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION (APPLIED ELECTRONICS DEPARTMENT)

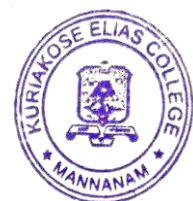
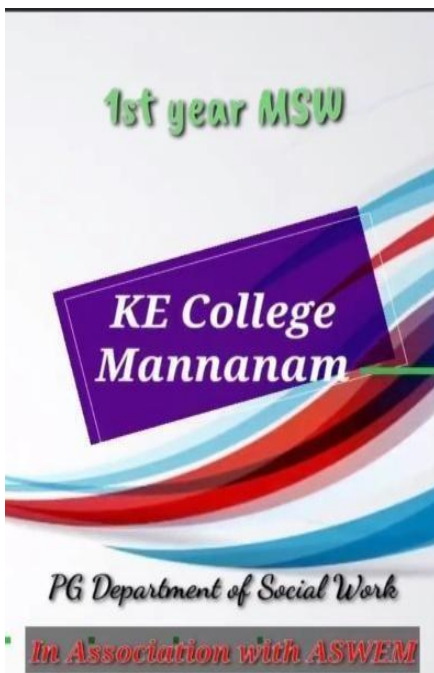
