




ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION (BHARAT KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV, ENGLISH DEPARTMENT)








LETTER WRITING COMPETITION (ENGLISH DEPARTMENT)






WRITE A BOOK REVIEW (ENGLISH DEPARTMENT)

A talent day was conducted on 26/07/2021 by the second-year students of the hemistry department via Google Meet. This helped the students to explore their talents and in making them self-confident.












WORLD POPULATION DAY-ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION (PG DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH)








RASHOMON FILM REVIEW CONTEST









INTER COLLEGIATE HINDI TRAVELOGUE COMPETITION (HINDI DEPARTMENT)








INTERNATIONAL YOUTH DAY DEBATE COMPETITION (ZOOLOGY DEPARTMENT)






ONLINE QUIZ COMPETITION IN ASSOCIATION WITH SBI (QUIZ CLUB)










ONLINE PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION (MSW)










COLLEGE ARTS FEST "MOOKNAYAK"
