III. Summary of API Scores

As stated in the UGC Regulations 2010, the API scoring will be progressively rolled out for categories I and II beginning with assessment of one year for selection committees in 2010-7011, annual averages of two years in 2011-2012 and so on. But for Category III, scores will be computed for the entire assessment period as already indicated in the Regulations.

IV.
