
1. The prescribed syllabus for the course was found to be suitable in this society



2. Syllabus is need based for employment or higher studies purpose





ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The analysis of the feedback collected from alumni revealed the following findings:

- The syllabus could be updated to incorporate topics more relevant to the clinical field.
- The college should offer internship opportunities to give students practical exposure and experience, allowing them to apply classroom knowledge to real-life scenarios.
- Enhance placement assistance to better support student job placement.
- Add more programs on skill development, extracurricular activities, gender sensitiveness, and human values.

Action taken based on the findings:

- The relevant clinical topics are communicated to students through classroom sessions, medical camps and related programmes.
- Collaborations were made with local businesses, industries, and organizations to create internship programs that provide students with practical experience.
- Expanded the college's career and placement services by appointing a dedicated staff to coordinate and manage internships, helping students secure placements that align with their academic interests.
- Value education programmes with defined syllabus are conducted as a part of the curriculum to impart moral values to our youth.



Action taken based on the findings:

- Initiated collaborations and MoUs with recognized institutions to offer our students enhanced learning opportunities.
- A series of workshops and seminars focusing on essential soft skills, such as communication, leadership, teamwork, and emotional intelligence, have been conducted through different training programmes.
- New initiatives, such as mock interview sessions, resume writing workshops, and career fairs, have been introduced to better prepare students for job applications and interviews.
